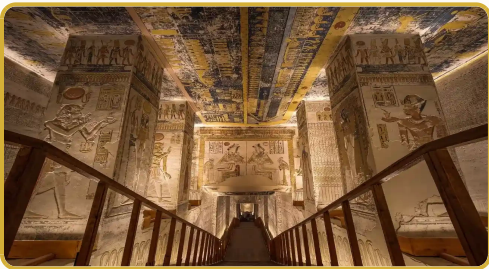

DAY 1

Day Trip To Luxor From Marsa Alam

In the morning, the day tour begins with your pickup from your hotel in Marsa Alam by our tour guide from Day Tours Egypt. You will then be transferred in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle.

Upon arrival in the land of remarkable civilizations, your day trip to Luxor will commence from Marsa Alam, where you will explore the most beautiful and famous sites.

The first stop will be the Luxor Temple, an ancient temple dedicated to Amun-Ra, one of the three main gods of ancient Egypt. This temple has stood for over 3,000 years and symbolizes the strength and endurance of ancient Egyptian civilization.

Currently, the temple is undergoing restoration work on its walls and columns, which were originally brightly colored.

Despite this, the structure remains well-preserved, offering a great insight into ancient life and how people lived back then. Next, you will visit the Karnak Temple, home to Amun-Ra, which is the second largest religious site in the world.

Your tour then proceeds to the West Bank of Luxor, where you will explore the Valley of the Kings. This was the burial site for pharaohs and their families from the 15th century BC up to the 10th century AD. The tombs are carved into the cliffs lining the valley, with each tomb having an entrance cut into the rock face. You will also visit the Hatshepsut Temple, dedicated to Pharaoh Hatshepsut, who ruled Egypt from 1479 BC to 1458 BC. This temple was built by Senemut, a high-ranking official who worked on many significant projects during her reign. He also served under her father and her brother, who became the next ruler after her death.

Along the way, you will also have the opportunity to visit some other notable places.

After lunch, your guide will take you on a half-hour Nile cruise in the heart of the Nile, allowing you to enjoy the beauty of the city and witness the majesty of ancient Egyptian heritage.

Finally, after a full day of exploring Luxor and enjoying a felucca ride along the Nile, you will return to your hotel in Marsa Alam by car.
