ITINERARY

DAY 1

Day 1: arrival in Cairo Welcome to Egypt

Upon arriving at Cairo International Airport, you will be met by a professional English-speaking tour guide who will welcome you in a private, air-conditioned car and assist you with all the necessary formalities. Then, you will be transferred to your Cairo Pyramids hotel for check-in, where you can rest and relax after your arrival. This **6 Days Cairo to Alexandria Tour package**.

DAY 2

Day 2: Visit to Memphis Pyramid

After your breakfast at the hotel, our tour guide will meet you in the lobby in the morning to begin your tour. Your first stop will be the Memphis Pyramid. Originally, the pyramid was about 52 meters high with a base measuring approximately 78 meters. However, a lot of the structure has been worn away or damaged over time, and today it stands at around 15 meters in height.

The Memphis Pyramid is different from other major pyramids in Egypt because it was not built using large, precisely cut stone blocks.

Instead, it was constructed using mud bricks that were later covered with limestone. This method of construction is one of the reasons why the pyramid has not lasted as long as similar structures at Giza and other sites in Egypt. DAY 3

Day 3: Impressive tour of the new Grand Egyptian Museum

Have breakfast, then a guide will pick you up from your place in Cairo. You will go to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization (NMEC). The museum holds many old objects. You can look at statues, wall art, pottery, and jewelry. The items cover a long timeline. They start with early periods and move through later eras up to today. A highlight is the Royal Mummies Hall. There you can see mummified remains of rulers from the New Kingdom. Examples include Ramses II and Hatshepsut. You can also find hands on parts and modern screens inside. There are teaching activities too. They are meant to help you understand Egyptian life and history in a clear way.

The visit also includes services for guests. There is a shop where you can buy souvenirs. You can also find a restaurant and a space for events. This **6 Days Cairo to Alexandria Tour package** gives you the opportunity to explore important historical sites as part of your **Cairo to Alexandria tour package**.

After that, you will travel from Cairo to Ismailia. Ismailia is in northeastern Egypt. It sits on the west side of the Suez Canal. The city has around 360,000 people. It is also where Suez Canal University is located. There are cultural and historical spots to see as well.

In Ismailia, you will view the Suez Canal. It is a man made channel that joins the Mediterranean Sea with the Red Sea. It helps ships move between Europe and Asia. They do not need to sail around the bottom of Africa. You will be able to watch how the canal works. You will also get a wide view of big ships passing through. Afterward, you will stop for a seafood lunch. Then you will be driven back to Cairo. This **6 day Egypt tour Cairo Alexandria**.

DAY 4

Day 4: Visiting in Alexandria:
