## DESCRIPTION

An enjoyable day trip to Dahshur, Memphis, and Meidum, departing from Cairo

On this day tour, you will visit the Great Pyramids of Giza and have the opportunity to travel back in time approximately 200 years before the reign of King Cheops, who is widely recognized for building the Great Pyramid of Giza.

This iconic landmark continues to captivate visitors with its stunning, unparalleled, and distinctive grandeur. Our Cairo day tours take you to the sacred necropolis of the capital of the Old Kingdom in ancient Egypt. You will see the first perfectly shaped Red Pyramid and the Bent Pyramid at Dahshur, followed by the Pyramid of Snefru, also known as the Meidum Pyramid. These remarkable structures, built over 4,650 years ago, were designed to endure the test of time and preserve the names of the kings and rulers who began the golden era in Egyptian history. Next, you will visit Memphis, the ancient capital of Egypt, now known as Mit Rahina.

This city features an open-air museum with impressive statues of King Ramses II from the New Kingdom. Your lunch will be served either during the tour or after you conclude your Cairo trips. Important note: You can visit these sites in any order you like. Our tour begins at Dahshur, the site farthest from Giza, and proceeds back towards the city.

The Egyptian Museum in Cairo houses a vast collection of artifacts and antiquities from ancient Egypt and beyond.

During the tour, you will be guided by specialized local tour guides who provide historical and cultural insights, enhancing your understanding and experience of Egyptian history.

Itinerary

Day Tour to Dahshur, Memphis and Meidum from Cairo

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will greet you and guide you through the ancient monuments and the remarkable Pyramids of Egypt, including the famous Pyramids of Giza. Now you have the opportunity to explore three pyramids built for King Snefru, who was the father of King Cheops, the builder of the Great Pyramid at Giza. Your tour begins with a visit to the first pyramid at Meidum, which is a step pyramid. You will then be taken to the area of Dahshur, where you will see the other two pyramids constructed for the same Pharaoh during the early 4th Dynasty of the Old Kingdom.

The Bent Pyramid is unique because it slightly changes direction in the middle due to the width of its base.

The Red Pyramid is the third largest pyramid in size, following the two tombs of King Cheops and King Chephren. Your day tour will continue to Dahshur, Memphis, and Meidum from Cairo, allowing you to view some of the most fascinating artifacts displayed in the world's oldest capital, Memphis, now known as Mit Rahina. Memphis features an open-air museum with colossal statues of King Ramses II from the New Kingdom. You will enjoy your lunch during your Egypt Day Tours or after completing your Cairo Trips.
