Day Tour to the Pyramids of Giza and the Tombs of Saqqara, Departing from Cairo

This tour offers a unique opportunity to experience the grandeur of ancient Egyptian history through our Egypt day tours. During the visit, you will explore the Pyramids of Giza and the Great Sphinx, as well as three tombs located within the Giza Pyramids complex. The city of Giza is home to a real cemetery city, which includes tombs, temples, roads, and sidewalks.

Participants will have the chance to explore the historic pyramids and gain insight into their significance in the history of ancient Egypt, within the Saqqara Necropolis.

Our tour includes a variety of activities in Saqqara, the famous necropolis of the ancient Kingdom, which dates back to the third dynasty. You will also have the opportunity to visit the Step Pyramid of Djoser, the oldest pyramid ever built and a significant part of Egyptian civilization that draws many tourists during their Egypt tours. In addition, you will explore the pyramid of Unas, the Egyptian pharaoh who was the ninth and last king of the Fifth Dynasty. This historical site, located near Cairo, features numerous tombs, temples, and monuments that date back to the Old Kingdom of Egypt.

The Tomb of Idut (Idu) is another highlight of the tour.

This tomb is famous for its colorful scenes that depict daily life, including fishing, scribes, a statue of the Princess, agricultural activities, papyrus harvest, livestock, and butchers.

The pyramid of Teti at Saqqara is also part of the tour.

Titi was the founder of the Sixth Dynasty and ruled Egypt after Pharaoh Unas. He followed Unas' example, with the central masonry constructed from tightly packed stone blocks, enclosed in fine limestone, and associated with many other kings.
