DESCRIPTION

Luxor, an Egyptian city known for its deep cultural and historical significance, is often referred to as the "greatest open-air museum in the world." On this guided tour, you will have the opportunity to visit several important sites in Luxor, including:

The Luxor Temple, which is situated on the east bank of the Nile River and was the center of the annual Opet festival in ancient Egypt.

The Valley of the Kings and the Valley of the Queens, two sites that contain the tombs of most ancient Egyptian pharaohs and queens. The Valley of the Queens holds over 90 tombs, while the Valley of the Kings contains more than 63 tombs. Dra' Abu El-Naga, where Queen Ahhotep is buried; she was a regent who ruled during the early years of Pharaoh Ahmose's reign and was instrumental in driving out the Hyksos rulers. The Ramesseum Temple, which was built as a memorial for Pharaoh Ramesses II. The Colossi of Memnon, which are two large stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III and are included in our Egypt day tours.
