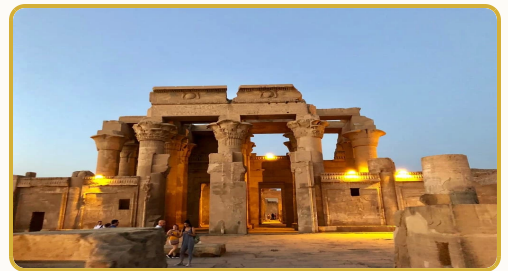
Next, you will head to the Temple of Kom Ombo, situated on a hillside overlooking the Nile.
