Cairo is considered the capital of Egypt and the largest metropolis in the Arab world, while Alexandria is well-known for its historical sites. So, when you're on vacation in Sharm el Sheikh, take the opportunity to enjoy a two-day flight to Cairo and Alexandria.

A convenient way to visit these two important Egyptian cities is by taking a flight from Sharm el Sheikh to Cairo and Alexandria.

Cairo is the capital of Egypt and features a wide range of historic landmarks and fascinating museums. There's a lot to see and do in the city, so it's best to spend several days exploring everything it has to offer. If you're interested in ancient Egyptian history, the Pyramids of Giza are a must-visit – they are among the most famous monuments in the world! The Giza Pyramids were constructed during the Fourth Dynasty of the Old Kingdom in ancient Egypt and are regarded as one of the top attractions in Cairo.

Alexandria is another popular destination for visitors to Egypt.

The city is situated on the Mediterranean Sea, offering plenty of beaches for relaxation. Alexandria also boasts many historical sites, such as Pompey's Pillar – a large column built in honor of the Roman Emperor Diocletian – and the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, one of the largest libraries in Africa with over 8 million books. The library was founded by King Ptolemy I and was used to house approximately 900,000 manuscripts during his rule.

Itinerary for 2 Days to Cairo and Alexandria from Sharm el Sheikh by plane

DAY 1

Day 1: Excursion to Cairo

Our tour guide will collect you in a modern, air-conditioned vehicle from your hotel in Sharm El Sheikh. The drive to Sharm El Sheikh Airport will give you time to board your domestic flight to Cairo. Upon arriving at Cairo Airport, our tour guide will be waiting for you in the arrivals area and will join you for the rest of the tour. The first stop on your tour will be the Egyptian Museum, where you can view the treasures of the young King Tutankhamun. The tour then moves on to the Pyramids of Giza, including the pyramids of Cheops, Khafre, and Menkaure, as well as the Great Sphinx. Afterward, you will be transported to your hotel in Cairo, where you will stay overnight.

DAY 2

Day 2: Excursion to Alexandria

After breakfast, the tour will continue. Our tour guide will meet you in the hotel lobby. The three-hour journey to Alexandria will include visits to some of the city’s most famous landmarks. The tour begins with a visit to the Qaitbay Citadel, built by Sultan Qaitbay in the 15th century atop the site of the ancient lighthouse. Next, you will see the Montazah Palace, an impressive example of a blend between Florentine and Turkish architectural styles. Following this, you will visit the newly built and highly praised Library of Alexandria. The final stop of the tour is the catacomb, a Roman cemetery carved into the rock. Afterward, you will be driven to the airport, where you can check in for your flight back to Sharm el Sheikh.
