Later, Egyptian scholar Gaston Maspero opened the museum in its current location in 1902, under the patronage of Khadiwah Abbas Halmi II. The museum contains much more than what is displayed, and an Egyptologist will share more details with you during your tour.

Next, you will visit the National Egyptian Museum of Civilization (NEMC), the first of its kind in Egypt and the Arab world.

It offers a comprehensive overview of Egyptian civilization from ancient times to the present. The museum highlights the relationship between Egyptians and the land they have inhabited throughout history, using cultural themes that showcase Egypt's material and intangible heritage. It also serves as an important educational and research center for both local and international visitors.

You will then have time to enjoy a delicious meal at a highly-rated local restaurant and have a soft drink as well. Finally, you will arrive at the Abdeen Museum, where you can explore the historical progress and development of Egypt.
