Description

Traveling from Sharm el Sheikh to Memphis and Dahshur in one day is difficult due to the great distance between these locations.

This day trip includes a visit to the ancient historical sites of Cairo, Giza, Dahshur, and Memphis.

These places showcase the impressive architectural achievements of the ancient Egyptians, including pyramids and temples. You will witness the extraordinary craftsmanship of the past and feel as though you have been transported back to an era of pharaohs and ancient legends. The experience offers a unique opportunity to explore these remarkable archaeological sites and create lasting memories.

This tour exceeded our expectations, especially with the added experience of a felucca ride after the day's activities.

The Dahshur archaeological area features the last two pyramids built there, which were eventually destroyed by time. Among them is the Black Pyramid from the 12th Dynasty, which is now in a severely damaged condition.

Itinerary for Flight to Memphis and Dahshor from Sharm

Your guide will meet you at the exit of the arrivals terminal. You can then start your tour by visiting Memphis, which was known as Noph or Moph in Hebrew. This was the traditional Egyptian town and capital of Lower Egypt, located on the Nile River near where modern Cairo is now.

Next, you will visit Dahshur, which is famous for its pyramids.

There are a total of eleven pyramids, but only three of them remain: the Bent Pyramid, the Red Pyramid, and the Black Pyramid.

You will then take a boat ride along the Nile River, which is a major north-flowing waterway in northeastern Africa.

Finally, you will be taken back to Cairo International Airport.
