Aswan, situated in the southern part of Egypt, is known for its breathtaking natural landscapes and deep historical roots.

It is a favored destination for travelers eager to discover its many attractions, such as the impressive Aswan High Dam, the lively Aswan Souk market, the intriguing Philae Temple, the remarkable Abu Simbel Temples, the colorful Nubian Village, Elephantine Island, and the enjoyable experience of a traditional felucca sail on the Nile. A luxurious multi-day trip along the Nile River offers an immersive journey into the region's historical and cultural treasures.

In Aswan, you will visit the Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis, and admire the engineering marvel of the High Dam. Your journey continues to Abu Simbel, where the magnificent temples of Ramses II and his beloved wife Nefertari are carved into the mountainside. These ancient structures showcase the grandeur and artistic mastery of Egyptian architecture.

Abu Simbel stands out as a major highlight of any Egyptian tour.

Day tours from Hurghada include visits to the temples, which were carved during the reign of Pharaoh Ramses II in the 13th century BC. The larger temple is dedicated to the gods Amun, Ra-Horakhty, and Ptah, while the smaller temple is dedicated to Queen Nefertari, the favorite wife of Ramses II. ITINERARY

DAY 1

Day 1: transfer to aswan

On the first day, we will collect you from your hotels and begin our journey from Hurghada to Aswan by train. You will be accompanied by our professional tour leader from Egypt tours, and the adventure on the land of the pharaohs will commence. Upon arrival in the Nubia region, you will meet your tour guide. Our first destination is the High Dam. This structure controls the river's water flow entirely, helps in water restoration, generates electricity, and safeguards Egypt from flooding. The second site is the Unfinished Obelisk. This monument was left incomplete due to a crack in the granite from which it was being extracted. Obviously, the work had to be halted because the granite rock was still partially connected to the main rock. You can learn more about this during our tour. The final stop of the day is the Philae Temple. Built in the middle of the great Nile River, this temple was dedicated to Isis, one of the ancient gods. As you visit the temple, you will learn the true story of Osorise and see the sites related to the story with your own eyes, as they are depicted on the temple walls. After that, you will enjoy a delicious lunch and have a good night's sleep.

DAY 2

Day 2: tour to abu simble

On the second day, start your morning with breakfast, check out of the hotel, and get ready to travel to Abu Simbel. The temple was constructed to honor the gods Amun, Ra-Horakhty, and Ptah. It is regarded as one of the most beautifully crafted temples from the time of Ramses II. At the end of the day, you will be returned to Aswan for lunch and then taken to your hotel in Hurghada, concluding this special and one-of-a-kind journey.
