ITINERARY

DAY 1

Luxor east and west banks tour

In the morning, our representative will collect you from your hotel in Marsa Alam using an air-conditioned car and take you to Luxor. Upon arrival in Luxor, our tour guide will be waiting for you and will accompany you on your trips to Luxor and Abu Simbel. Your first activity will be a visit to the famous West Bank sites, including:

Valley of the Kings

The Valley of the Kings is home to many temples that are carved into the mountainside and served as the main burial site for Pharaohs.

It contains over 60 tombs.

Next, you will visit:

Hatshepsut Temple

The Temple of Queen Hatshepsut consists of several temples and tombs and is built in three ascending levels. Hatshepsut was a powerful ruler who was deeply loved by her people, though she was also surrounded by controversy.

Following this, you will be taken to:

Colossi of Memnon

The two Memnon Colossi are the only two statues remaining from the funerary temple built by Amenhotep III. Many historians and rulers have inscribed their names on these statues.

After visiting the Colossi of Memnon, you will enjoy a delicious lunch at a restaurant with a view of the Nile.

Your safety is our top priority, and we are committed to completing your two-day journey from Marsa Alam to Luxor and Abu Simbel.

Later, your tour guide will transfer you to the East Bank to conclude your first day with a visit to the:

Temple of Karnak

The Temple of Karnak is one of the largest ancient religious complexes and represents the combined efforts of many generations of Egyptian builders.

It consists of three adjacent temples: the main temple, a smaller temple, and an outer temple.

In the evening, our representative will take you by a private, air-conditioned vehicle to Aswan for an overnight stay at a 5-star hotel.

You can relax and enjoy your evening on the way.

DAY 2

Abu Simbel Tour

In the morning, continue your two-day trip from Marsa Alam to Luxor and Abu Simbel.You will have a delicious breakfast at your hotel in Aswan.Your tour guide will then pick you up from the hotel to conclude your tour with a visit to:

The Temples of Abu Simbel

Abu Simbel is an archaeological site featuring two temples, the Small Temple and the Large Temple, both carved directly into the rock.

These temples were built during the reign of Pharaoh Ramses II between 1279 and 1213 BC.

The temples were constructed to commemorate Ramses II's victory in the Battle of Kadesh.

The Large Temple was dedicated to the god Ptah and Ramses II himself, while the Small Temple was dedicated to the goddess Hathor and Nefertiti, the wife of Ramses II.

Following this, you will enjoy lunch in Aswan.

Then, our representative will take you to catch a first-class train to Luxor, after which he will transfer you to your hotel in Marsa Alam.
