DAY 1

transfer to Luxor

The first day is the pick-up day. You will be picked up by our professional tour leader from Cairo Top Tours. The tour leader will accompany you to the best sites to visit. Then you will meet our tour guide in Luxor, as you will be traveling by car directly from Marsa Alam to Luxor.

The journey will begin.

First, you will visit the Valley of Kings.

The Valley of Kings is famous for its tombs, which are not just ancient Egyptian tombs but royal tombs.

These tombs feature beautiful and mysterious paintings that still remain on their walls, preserved for over a thousand years. You should visit it to learn more about this fascinating place.

Next, you will go to the second site, which is the Hatshepsut Temple.

This temple is dedicated to the ancient queen Hatshepsut, who ruled Egypt in the past.

This temple was dedicated to Amun Ra and was the largest temple in ancient times at its peak.

It now contains many quarries and remains one of the most significant religious sites of the ancient world.

DAY 2

flying to Cairo

On day two, which is the final day of your trip, you will have the opportunity to explore some of Cairo's most famous attractions and also enjoy some shopping if you wish to purchase souvenirs. However, your first stop will be the Great Pyramids of Giza. These are one of the seven wonders of the world, and even today, the exact method used to build them remains a mystery—only theories and ideas exist about their construction.

We will take you to the largest of these pyramids, which was built for the great Pharaoh Khufu.

There are still no discovered inner chambers, and the location of the King’s Chamber remains unknown. The pyramid was designed to welcome the soul of the Pharaoh back to life after his death, allowing him to live an eternal existence.

Next, you will visit the Great Sphinx.

This massive statue was created to intimidate and scare off enemies. Its face is that of a human, while its body is shaped like a lion, symbolizing both intelligence and strength. The Sphinx is considered a powerful figure, representing both human wisdom and lion-like power.

Following that, you will see the Valley Temple.

This temple was the home of Pharaoh Khafra and was built to welcome him back after death, based on the ancient belief in resurrection and immortality.

After this, you will have lunch to refresh and prepare for the rest of your journey.
