Giza Pyramids:

The Giza Pyramids are located on the Giza Plateau in the Giza Governorate, on the west bank of the Nile River. These pyramids were built about 25 centuries ago, between 2480 and 2550 B.C. The site includes three main pyramids: the pyramids of Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure.

Saqqara:

Saqqara is home to pyramids built by sixteen other Egyptian kings, as well as some funerary monuments constructed by high-ranking officials from ancient times.

The area stretching from the Giza Pyramids to Dahshur, passing through Saqqara, was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1979.

Old Cairo

Old Cairo is home to some of the most significant historical landmarks in ancient Egypt.

This area is notable for its connection to the three monotheistic religions: Islam, Christianity, and Judaism.It includes the Amr Ibn Al-Aas Mosque, which is the first mosque in Egypt and Africa, and the fourth to be built in the Islamic world.The area also features the Church of the Virgin Mary, commonly known as the Hanging Church, along with several other churches.

After a delicious lunch during your day of visits, your journey will continue.

Khan El Khalili Bazaar:

The Khan al-Khalili neighborhood has inspired many Egyptian writers, including the famous Naguib Mahfouz. He wrote a novel set in this area, titled "Khan al-Khalili," which was later adapted into a movie starring actor Emad Hamdy.

Al Muizz Street:

Al Muizz Street is currently considered the largest open museum of Islamic antiquities in the world. It is also a unique heritage site and was included in the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1979.

Enjoy your dinner on a Nile cruise as you sail along the Nile River.
