The Red Pyramid, also known as the Northern Pyramid, is the largest pyramid found at Dahshur, which is located in the Giza area of Egypt. This pyramid is named after the rusty-red color of the limestone stones used in its construction. It is also the third largest pyramid in Egypt, following the pyramids of Khufu and Khafre at Giza. It is believed to be the first successful attempt by the ancient Egyptians to build a true smooth-sided pyramid.

Dahshur is an ancient royal burial site located approximately 40 kilometers (25 miles) from Cairo.

It is about 11 kilometers away from the Saqqara necropolis. This site contains the first complete pyramid built by King Senefru. Dahshur is a place rich in ancient artifacts and historical treasures. Many artifacts have been discovered in the tombs and pyramids located there. The pyramids of Egypt have become a famous and well-known tourist destination that attracts visitors from all over the world. There are many pyramids in Dahshur, including the Bent Pyramid, the Black Pyramid of King Amenemhat III, and the Pyramid of King Senusret III.

The red pyramid, the third in size, follows the Great Pyramid of Giza and the Pyramid of King Chefred.

Your day tour will continue to visit Dahshur and Meidum from Cairo, where you will explore the most fascinating artifacts displayed in the oldest capital of the world, the city of Memphis, now known as Mit Rahina.

This area features an open-air museum with a large collection of statues of King Ramesses II from the New Kingdom.

You will enjoy lunch provided during your daily tours in Egypt.

Afterward, you will take a felucca cruise along the Nile Valley, offering a unique view of the country's beauty and civilization from one of its most scenic spots.
